## Academy to move to 56th, L Streets

The search is over for Omaha Christian Academy's new home.

The school will move from the building that once housed Westbrook Junior High to space at Liberty Christian Center, at 56th and L Streets, administrator Timothy Koehn announced Wednesday.

The prekindergarten through 12th-grade school has been looking for a new home since its landlord, Westside Community Schools, decided not to renew its lease last May. Negotiations with Liberty began in mid-January.

Classroom space will be comparable, Koehn said of the building, but there is no gymnasium.

This year the school serves 342 students.

The school will take its current playground equipment along to the new site, he said, and students will be able to use the existing athletic fields.

Older students will be on the building's third floor, which the school will renovate this summer. Younger students will be in classrooms on the lower levels.
