

2005 Magazine Sales Update

We jumped out with real strong sales the first week, selling 844 items towards our goal of 2251. The second week we did about the same with 847 sales. With sales a little down, and busy schedules at the beginning of school it was decided to extend the sale an extra four days, until the following Monday. We brought in 75 more sales, totaling 1766. Elementary ended up just 65 sale items short of their goal, middle school was 247 sale items short, and high school was 173 sale items short of their goal. Overall, when it came to dollars, we were able to bring in what the board had budgeted! It was truly a "God Thing" as for the past few years the board budgeted \$15,000 for profit to OCA. Last year the magazine sale brought in over \$16,000. This year with the move and a few less students, they budgeted \$13,000. Our total sales dollars were about \$35,000, with 40% to OCA, less expenses, **will bring the school over \$13,500!** Yea! We didn't need to raise tuition! With many people giving to Katrina and with the gas prices going up, and in looking at the final income to the school, it was successful! **Thank you for all your efforts to bring this \$ to OCA!**

Who will be the "Keeper of the Eagle"? This week it will be announced who the top sellers were, and the top selling class. I will say that, the top selling class is between Mr. Arndt's 4th grade class and Mr. Schmidt's Physics class. The top selling class is determined by the highest average sales per student. Last year Mrs. Saiz's class averaged 10.16 sales to win! They will be passing on the "Top Selling Class" Eagle Award.
