We were off to a good start with the Magazine Sales drive with the first day bringing in 696 sales! There were 233 candy bars given away after the 2nd turn in day. Internet sales played a big factor, bringing in 143 sales. The last turn in day brought in 426. When the students left school we were 17 sales away. Some late orders came in after school, and we were 2 orders short a ½ hour later! The goal thermometer was marked showing 2 sales short. It was decided to allow sales to still come in Friday morning until 8:30 to still earn tickets and apply towards goals. When I came Friday morning, I heard many students talking with other students, that we met the goal, because they brought in one or two sales that morning. They were right, they and everyone helped play a part in making our goal! Friday morning, there were 20 more internet sales and 40 more sales that came in that morning! Total sales brought in, 1558! The last time that we made goal was 2002!
